An ecology trip to Burgundy

The first teaching / learning / training activities meeting of the Erasmus+ Ka2 project: "BRINGING UP NEW ECO-SCIENTISTS" (BEECOS) - coordinated by the Catalan Institut Ramon de la Torre took place from 28 January to 3 February 2018 at the "Lycée Clos Maire" in the French town Beaune belonging to the Burgundy region. After the warm welcome, getting acquainted with both school facilities and city sights was done through an application created with the help of App Inventor's open visual programming environment.

PIEZOELECTRIC ACTIVITY



Following the objectives of the program in the school's workshops, the French teachers urged students to reuse the lost mechanical energy they produced by turning it into electrical via piezo-electric devices.

CALCULATING THE ECOLOGICAL FOOTPRINT OF THE SCHOOL CAFETERIA



Through an activity which calculated the energy consumed for the operation of the school building and the restaurant, they were led to find the ecological footprint and the proposed solutions to reduce it.

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DEHYDRATION OF ORGANIC FOOD WASTE

Finally, drawing on the example of the school for the dehydration of organic food waste, through chemical reactions and energy consumption calculations, they came into contact with alternative proposals to reduce energy consumption by comparing transportrecycling and dehydration costs for possible alternative use.











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EDUCATIONAL VISIT TO THE "INFINEO" RECYCLING CENTER AND A WASTE SORTING CENTER

The culmination of the educational activity was the visit to the Infineo recycling center, a joint venture between Plastipak Packaging and Coca-Cola Enterprises, with two objectives: to maintain and develop the recycling industry for plastic bottles in France and to educate 5,000 young people each year on cyclical issues.

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THE GAUGRY DAIRY



Combining "business with pleasure" we visited the Gaugry dairy, the last one to produce authentic traditional Epoisses cheese with fresh milk, we tasted French cheeses but at the same time we learned that part of the energy needed for the dairy is produced by converting the liquid waste into methane and using it for heating.

The program was enriched with a cultural tour of the historic city of Dijon, the capital of Burgundy, and a tour at the largest wine cellar of Burgundy, "PATRIARCHE", 5 km long and with a history of 230 years.


